

766 young people from the Transnistrian region are studying in state-funded places at technical vocational and higher education institutions on the right bank of the Nistru River



According to data from the first semester of 2025, provided by the Ministry of Education and Research, 766 young people from the Transnistrian region benefited from state-funded places in educational institutions on the right bank of the Nistru River:

- 459 places in higher education;
- 307 in technical vocational education.

The average cost covered by the state per student was 16,486.14 lei, while for students enrolled in ISCED level III vocational training programs (vocational schools), the cost was 23,700 lei, and for ISCED levels IV and V (colleges and centers of excellence), it was 29,300 lei.

It is also noteworthy that from March 28, 2018, to June 30, 2025 national authorities applied the Moldovan apostille to 643 neutral-format diplomas issued to young people from the Transnistrian region, allowing them to continue their studies in EU member states, the United Kingdom, Canada, the USA, Israel, and others.

The reintegration of young people from the Transnistrian region into the national and international education system is a strategic priority for the Republic of Moldova. This process helps align educational standards and strengthen a shared space of values, rights, and opportunities.
