

# Chisinau sent 1810 doses of anti-COVID-19 vaccine to Tiraspol, offered as a donation from Romania to the Republic of Moldova



The 1810 doses of vaccine, that are part of the humanitarian aid provided by Romania to the Republic of Moldova for immunization of the population on both banks of Nistru, were transmitted by the representatives of national institutions and taken over by the medical specialists from the Transnistrian region.

It is worth mentioning that the taking over, administration and monitoring of reactions on vaccine of the population on both banks of Nistru at the first stage of vaccination were the main topics of discussions between the Healthcare Working Group experts from Chisinau and Tiraspol. These topics were also addressed at the recently organized training courses, led by professionals from the Ministry of Health, Labor and Social Protection and the National Agency for Public Health, with the support of the World Health Organization.
