

Prime Minister met with EU Representative for Transnistrian settlement



Prime Minister Alexandru Munteanu held a meeting with Audrone Perkauskiene, EU Representative for the Transnistrian settlement process, Deputy Director-General for Eastern Europe and Central Asia at the European External Action Service.

The officials discussed the progress made by the Republic of Moldova in advancing its European agenda and implementing key reforms.
