Working visit of the Deputy Prime Minister for Reintegration to Dubăsari district



On September 30, 2024, Deputy Prime Minister for Reintegration Oleg Serebrian, together with MP Roman Rosca, Chairman of the Special Commission for Parliamentary Monitoring and Control over the Implementation of Reintegration Policies of the Republic of Moldova, as well as representatives of the Bureau for Reintegration Policies, paid a working visit to the communes of Cocieri, Molovata and Molovata Nouă in the Dubăsari district.

During the meetings with representatives of local authorities, the education sector, farmers who own agricultural lands located beyond the Râbniţa-Tiraspol road, as well as with residents of these settlements, the socio-economic situation, artificial barriers to free movement created by the so-called security forces of the Transnistrian region were discussed.

Meanwhile, during the visit of Deputy Prime Minister Oleg Serebrian to the Roghi Gymnasium, one of the eight Romanian-language schools in the Transnistrian region, it was emphasized that the proper functioning of the gymnasium is under constant control of the constitutional authorities of Chişinău. At the same time, the efforts of the gymnasium administration aimed at increasing the number of pupils were noted and encouraged. Thus, in comparison with the previous school year, the number of schoolchildren this year has increased by 20% due to the involvement of pupils from the village of Țâbuleuca and the town of Dubăsari – settlements located in the perimeter temporarily not under the control of the constitutional authorities.

Deputy Prime Minister Oleg Serebrian drew attention to the benefits provided by European integration, European and national development programs, with the implementation of projects with major impact on the Security Zone, especially in the field of local infrastructure development.
