In the context of maintaining an interactive dialogue platform with the young generation, during interactive discussions with a group of young people from both banks of the Nistru River, participants of the summer camp "Young People for PEACE", organized by the Public Association "Initiative 4 Peace", the team of the Bureau for Reintegration Policies presented and explained the specificity of the Transnistrian issue and the governmental priorities in the field of the country's reintegration policies.

The Head of the Bureau Alin Gvidiani reported on the activity, mission and files managed by the Bureau, the dialogue formats on the Transnistrian settlement, the governmental and parliamentary commissions on the country's reintegration, the priority actions in this area, the role of international partners, the perspectives and opportunities offered to both banks of the Nistru River in the context of the European integration process of the Republic of Moldova.
