Topical subjects for inhabitants on both banks of the Nistru River were on the agenda of the second meeting of the year of the Special Monitoring and **Parliamentary Control Commission on** Implementation of the Reintegration Policies of the Republic of Moldo



On Monday, May 27, 2024, Deputy Prime Minister for Reintegration Oleg Serebrian participated in the second meeting of the year of the Special Commission on Parliamentary Monitoring and Control over the Implementation of the Reintegration Policies of the Republic of Moldova.

The meeting was chaired by the deputy Roman Rosca, chairman of the Special Commission, with the participation of members of the Commission, representatives of the Bureau for Reintegration Policies, Ministry of Finance, Ministry of Labor and Social Protection, Ministry of Agriculture and Food Industry, General Inspectorate of Police, Public Services Agency, Customs Service.

The agenda of the meeting included the issue of vehicles from the Transnistrian region, additional support measures for owners of agricultural lands in Dubăsari district located after the Râbnita-Tiraspol road, ways of providing assistance to victims of abuses in the eastern districts of the country.

The institutional positions and proposals on the above-mentioned topics were heard and it was agreed that optimal intervention mechanisms will be identified in order to solve the existing problems, in the interests of the inhabitants on both banks of the Nistru river.
