Working visit of the Deputy Prime Minister for Reintegration to Varnița



On November 13, 2025, Deputy Prime Minister for Reintegration Valeriu Chiveri paid a working visit to the village of Varniţa, Anenii Noi district, to assess on the ground the current situation of the community and the urgent needs of the population.

During a meeting with the mayor of Varniţa, Alexandr Nichitenco, the Deputy Prime Minister discussed the implementation of local development projects and the identification of solutions for modernizing infrastructure. The importance of intensifying efforts to ensure efficient and sustainable management of energy resources was also highlighted.

"We are here to clarify the existing issues and intervene promptly so that the community benefits from the necessary support and safe living conditions," stated Deputy Prime Minister Valeriu Chiveri.

Human rights-related topics were analyzed in a discussion with the representative of the People's Advocate Office, Veaceslav Ursu. Frequent violations recorded in the Transnistrian region were highlighted, including: the right to liberty and security, the prohibition of torture and inhuman or degrading treatment, restrictions on freedom of expression and access to information, limitations on freedom of movement, and violations of the right to education.

The Deputy Prime Minister stressed the need for ongoing monitoring of the human rights situation in the Transnistrian region and the importance of increased efforts to protect and promote these rights.

"We must ensure the full observance of human rights in the region. Democracy and the protection of fundamental freedoms are essential values that we will defend unconditionally," the Deputy Prime Minister emphasized.

As part of the visit, Valeriu Chiveri also held a dialogue with the staff of the Bender Police Inspectorate. The official expressed his gratitude to the police officers for their demonstrated professionalism and for their efforts in maintaining public order and strengthening public trust in the state's law enforcement institutions on the territory of the municipality of Bender.
