

Physical education and sports to be covered by new law



5 February 2025, Chişinău – The Cabinet of Ministers today approved a new draft law on [physical education and sports](#). The document will focus on supporting performance sports, strengthening physical education in schools and popularizing healthy lifestyle. Regarding performance sports, the draft provides for a more efficient allocation of funds to sports federations and clubs, as well as clear criteria for recognizing structures that contribute to the development of this field. Additionally, monthly allowances will be paid to top-performing athletes, including those on medical or maternity leave, and lifetime allowances to athletes and coaches, depending on results.

It also prioritizes the training of teachers in the physical education, the development of sports infrastructure and the promotion of Olympic and Paralympic movements.

In recent years, thanks to improved training conditions, increased financial allocations for sports activities, allowances for top athletes, the Republic of Moldova has won a record number of medals in Olympic and non-Olympic events.
