

Specialists from Chisinau trained the health representatives from the Transnistrian region on the vaccination process against COVID-19, with the support of the WHO



On 26 February, 2021, the health representatives from the Transnistrian region were trained on the administration of the anti-COVID-19 vaccines within a seminar initiated by the specialists from the right bank of Nistru. It was organized online, with the support of the Ministry of Health, Labor and Social Protection, the National Agency for Public Health and the World Health Organization.

The course was conducted in accordance with the provisions of the Order of the Ministry of Health, Labor and Social Protection no.140 of 22 February, 2020, and coordinated with the Bureau for Reintegration as a follow-up to agreements reached at the recent meetings of the sectoral experts from both banks of Nistru. It also ensured the implementation of the provisions of the National Anti-COVID-19 Immunization Plan, approved by the Decision of the Extraordinary National Commission for Public Health no.41 of 13 January, 2021.

The seminar was attended by the personnel of medical, pharmaceutical, dental, diagnostic and laboratory services, as well as by teachers and students from the relevant educational institutions from the eastern districts of the country. The participants were informed about the properties, particularities of distribution and management of events related to vaccination against COVID-19, and about other important technical aspects for an efficient administration of the vaccine as to reduce morbidity and mortality caused by COVID-19.

The specialists from the right bank of Nistru and WHO representatives will continue the good organization and coordination of the immunization process of the population on both banks of the Nistru river, from the moment the vaccines reach the territory of the

Republic of Moldova, by following the established communication channels between Chisinau and Tiraspol in relation to the recipients from the Transnistrian region.
