

Meeting of the Deputy Prime Minister for reintegration with the special representative of the Chairperson-in-Office of the OSCE on gender issues, Liliana Palihovici



On January 25, 2023, the Deputy Prime Minister for Reintegration Oleg Serebrian had a meeting with the Special Representative of the OSCE Chairperson-in-Office on Gender Issues, Liliana Palihovici, and the OSCE Senior Adviser on Gender Issues, Lara Scarpitta.

The discussions focused on the activities connected to the good implementation by the Republic of Moldova of the international commitments regarding the gender dimension, including those arising from Resolution 1325 of the UN Security Council on Women, Peace and Security.

Deputy Prime Minister Oleg Serebrian mentioned the need to promote international norms in the field of respecting women's rights on both banks of the Nistru River, with the assurance of prompt intervention by the actors involved in the process.

Liliana Palihovici emphasized the importance of promoting a good understanding by the OSCE member states of the international security implications that can be generated by gender inequalities and the representation of women in the processes of ensuring peace and security, as well as on democracy and sustainable development.

The interlocutors agreed to continue an active interaction on the areas of responsibility under their management in order to attract the necessary support from external partners and to achieve the expected results.
