

The issue of illegal checkpoints in the Security Zone was discussed during the meeting of the Joint Control Commission



On December 7, the weekly meeting of the Joint Control Commission took place in the city of Bender. The main topic of discussion remained the checkpoints of the force structures subordinate to Tiraspol, which were arbitrarily installed within the responsibility perimeter of the Joint Peacekeeping Forces.

The OSCE Mission presented the new composition of its representatives in the Commission and distributed its monthly report on monitoring the situation in the Security Zone.

The report confirms that at several illegal checkpoints, from Camenca to Slobozia, new guard booths have been installed for the shelter of representatives of Transnistrian region force structures.

Regarding the metal barrier on the road section between Varnița and Bender, it is noted that the work is partially completed.

Representatives of the OSCE Mission also examined the work carried out by S.A. "Drumuri Criuleni" along the route between the localities Slobozia-Dușca and Criuleni. They were informed by the district leadership that activities are being carried out to drain groundwater and prevent it from reaching the road surface.

It is worth mentioning that earlier, members of the transnistrian region delegation launched insinuations in the media regarding this engineering project. The distorted

statements from Tiraspol represented an unsuccessful attempt to divert public attention from the unauthorized works carried out by transnistrian region structures on the road connecting the localities Bender and Varnița, with the aim of creating obstacles to the free movement of citizens.
