Developments on the Transnistrian file, governmental priorities in promoting the country's reintegration policies, and the ongoing efforts of the authorities in the Republic of Moldova to address the pressing issues of residents on both banks of the Nistru river and restore the unified national spaces were the subject of discussions between the head of the Bureau for Reintegration Policies, Alin Gvidiani, and a group of researchers, political analysts, journalists, and representatives of civil society from the Federal Republic of Germany.

The head of the Bureau reiterated the firm commitment of Chisinau to achieve a peaceful and comprehensive settlement of the Transnistrian conflict, aiming to strengthen the statehood of the Republic of Moldova, secure state borders throughout, ensure the territorial integrity of the country, and fully implement the assumed public policy priorities across the entire territory.

The benefits and opportunities provided by the European integration process, felt on both banks of the Nistru river, were highlighted, bringing new momentum to the implementation of the country's reintegration policies in various sectors.
