

A new batch of high-performance medical equipment for patients with COVID-19 was donated to the residents of Nistru's left bank and Bender



On April 23, the medical institutions from the Transnistrian region received a new batch of high-performance medical equipment for the treatment and rehabilitation of patients with moderate and severe forms of COVID-19. The batch consisted of 20 oxygen concentrators and 20 kits of spare parts and accessories for them, 40 nasal oxygen cannulas (20 for adults and 20 for children), and 40 "Venturi" masks (20 for adults and 20 for children).

This equipment was part of the aid donated to the Republic of Moldova by the Federal Government of Germany and the World Health Organization.

We would like to remind that apportionments for beneficiaries from the left bank of Nistru and from Bender were made from all batches of the humanitarian aid that were offered to the Republic of Moldova, including on supporting the national efforts to protect, prevent, combat and treat the COVID-19 infection.

Through such actions, the Chisinau authorities show constant concern for the life and health of the citizens on both banks of Nistru, especially during the pandemic.
