

The educational process within "Lucian Blaga" theoretical lyceum from Tiraspol and the activity of the institution will continue to be developed



10.08.2021, Chisinau – The Bureau for Reintegration makes the following clarifications in the context of the notification received from the People's Advocate for children rights and information circulated in some media sources, with reference to possible suspension of the activity of „Lucian Blaga” theoretical lyceum from Tiraspol for a period of 3 months following a recent „decision” issued in the Transnistrian region.

Chisinau has informed the mediators and observers of the „5 + 2” negotiation format about those circumstances immediately after they became known. Also, Chisinau has made use of the dialogue channel of political representatives in the Transnistrian settlement process and notified Tiraspol about its concerns on potential premeditated tensioning of the situation related to this educational institution. Moldovan authorities called for ensuring compliance with previous agreements, refraining from unilateral actions, eliminating artificial barriers and contributing without delay to solving the identified problems.

The Bureau for Reintegration and the Deputy Prime Minister for Reintegration remain in close contact with the Political Representative on behalf of Tiraspol, the OSCE Mission to Moldova, relevant international partners and representatives of the lyceum’s management.

In the situation today, previously noted difficulties have been overcome as a result of efforts and constructive interaction. The institution restarted its functional activity and prepares for the beginning of the new academic year and organization of a qualitative study process.

It should be highlighted that approximately similar difficulties were previously reported by „Evrika” theoretical lyceum from Ribnita. Prompt measures were applied in order to bring the processes back to normal.

The Bureau for Reintegration together with the Ministry of Education and Research will constantly monitor the situation of all 8 Latin script educational institutions from the Transnistrian region in order to ensure their proper functioning and development of the educational process in accordance with national and international requirements.
